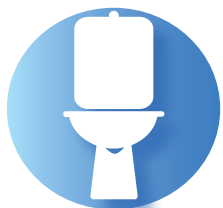
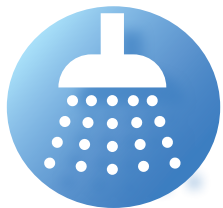

What the Label says

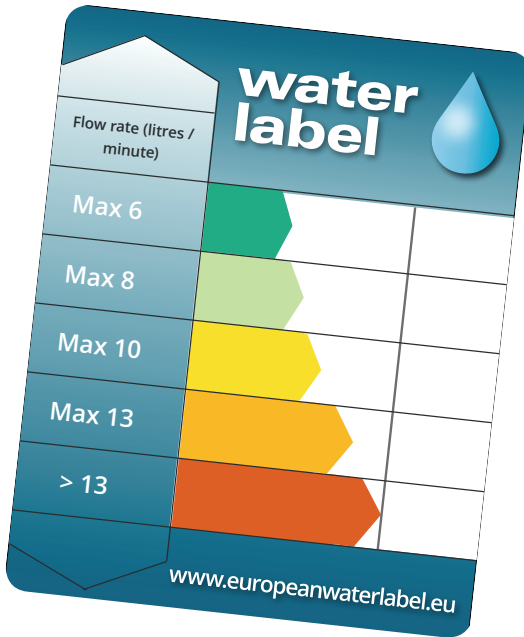
It clearly shows the maximum volume of water that the product will deliver if installed correctly and according to the manufacturer's instructions.
